## STATEMENT ABOUT REACH

Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) is a European Union regulation EC No. 1907/2006. Polymers are in general exempt from the obligation to register under REACH, because they are mixtures (preparations). Therefore, all our products made from the polymers do not have to be (pre-) registered.

The individual parts of the mixtures, all building blocks of the polymers, must be (pre-) registeredthe requirements of Article 6(3) of the REACH regulation.

According to the statements of our raw material suppliers and our present knowledge, all substances present in the raw materials which we use to produce our food grade products in an amount  $\geq 2\%$  by weight, have been (pre-) registered.

According to the statements of our raw material suppliers and our present knowledge, substances mentioned in the Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern for Authorisation (most recent update from January 17, 2022) mentioned in the link: https://echa.europa.eu/candidate-list-table

are not present in the concentrations above 0,1% w/w in the Flestic B.V. food grade products.

From January 5, 2021 suppliers of articles on the EU-market containing Candidate List substances in a concentration above 0.1% weight by weight must notify these articles to ECHA's SCIP-database. Our food grade products are not obligated to be registered in SCIP-database.
